I am so excited you will be in my kindergarten class in September! We are going to have such a fun time learning together. To get the school year off to a terrific start, we are asking you to get the following supplies:

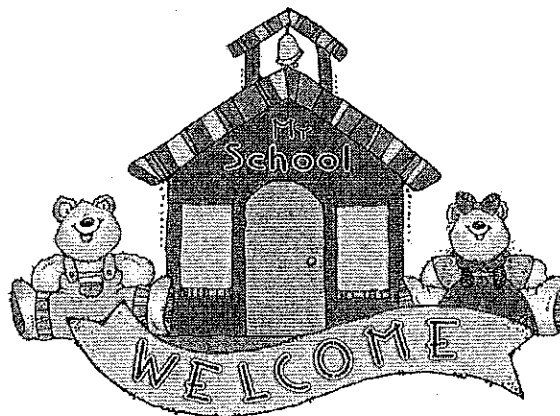
- A paint shirt - An old t-shirt that fits over your clothes works best.

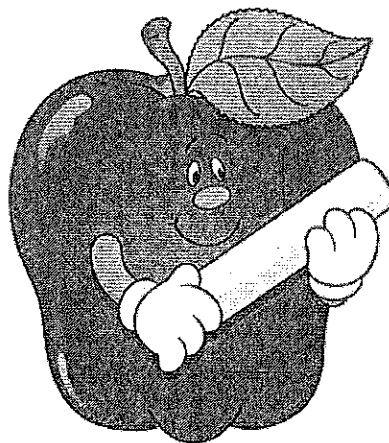

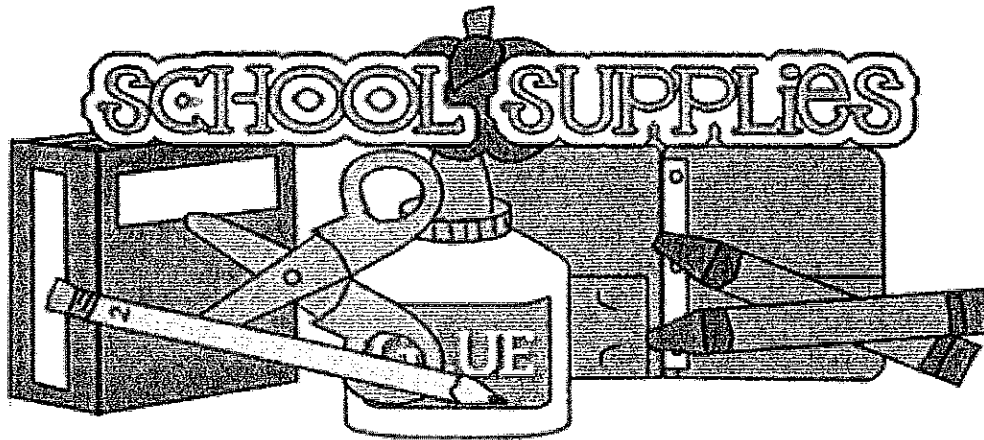
- 2 Marble Composition books (glued binding, they hold together better)

If you are bringing a lunch box, make sure it has your child's name clearly written on the outside.

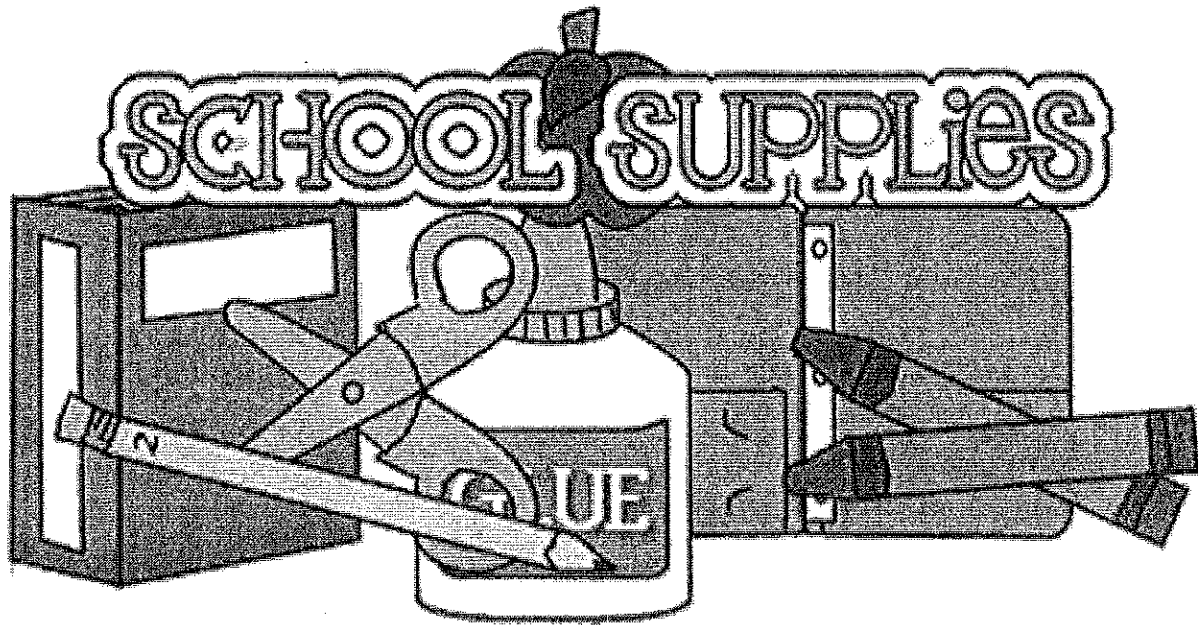

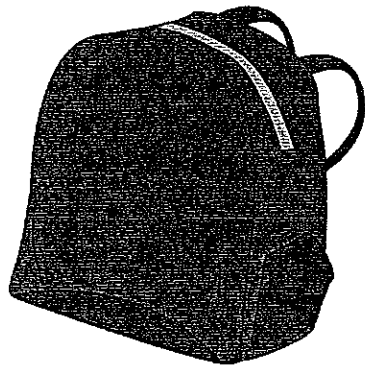
